AN ORDINANCE WITH ADDITIONAL LIMITATIONS TO NC URBAN ARCHERY
SEASON REGULATIONS WITHIN TOWN LIMITS

WHEREAS, the Town of Denton Ordinances does not currently permit deer bow hunting as part of the NC Wildlife Commission's Urban Archery Season; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Commissioners approved participation in the 2018 Urban Archery Season at its March 20, 2017 regular meeting, joining 51 other NC cities & towns, as one method to limit deer population & interference in urban areas; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Denton Board of Commissioners called for a public hearing to be held December 4, 2017 at 6:00pm in Town Hall to consider amending Town Ordinances that would include additional limitations to the NC Urban Archery season regulations within Town limits.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town of Denton Board of Commissioners to amend the Town of Denton Ordinances Chapter XI General Administration New Article D NC Urban Archery Season Regulations to read as follows:


" Section 1. In any year in which the Town of Denton Board of Commissioners has approved participation in the NC Urban Archery Season as authorized by the NC Wildlife Commission, the following additional requirements shall apply:

- Deer bow hunting during the Urban Archery Season is limited to the corporate limits of the Town.
- Hunters must have written permission from land owners to hunt.
- Hunters must hunt from an elevated position or platform of 10 feet.
- No hunting allowed on property owned by the Town of Denton.
- No arrow shall be discharged within 50 yards of a school, church, daycare or park.
