



**AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A STREET CLOSURE FOR THE  
ANNUAL CHRISTMAS PARADE**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Denton acknowledges that the annual Christmas Parade will be conducted again this year in downtown Denton, on the first Saturday of December and;

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Denton acknowledges that this Parade requires closure of certain streets for the safe conduct of the parade, to permit traffic control and protect pedestrians;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Denton pursuant to the authority granted by N.C.G.S. 20-169 that they do hereby declare a temporary road closure during the day and times set forth below on the following described portion of a State Highway System Route:

**Date: Annually, First Saturday in December**

**Times: 10:00 a.m. until 1:30p.m.**

**Street Closing Description: South Main Street, from Peacock Avenue to Salisbury Street; First Street, from Garner Street to North Main Street, North Main Street, from First Street to Salisbury Street and Salisbury Street From Garner Street to Hulin Street**


This ordinance to become effective when signs are erected giving notice of the limits and times of the Parade, and implementation of adequate traffic control to guide vehicles around the parade street closure.

Upon a motion by Commissioner Loflin, seconded by Commissioner Hogan, the foregoing Ordinance was passed by a vote of 5/0.
